Tsunami Relief Efforts of Evason Phuket

Evason Phuket, July 2005: When the horrifying December 26 Tsunami hit Phuket in 2004 the immediate response of Evason Phuket & Six Senses Spa was to do relief work.

The resort's hosts were released to take action without fearing for their job. For example, the carpenters were sent to build coffins for casualties. Furthermore, the resort donated operating equipment worth USD 85,000.

The resort also coordinated fund raising, which in the end resulted in USD 300,000 being raised. The money was spent on Ban Bangmuang school in Khao Lak, the area worst hit by the Tsunami. A library was also built and was named Evason Self Learning Centre.

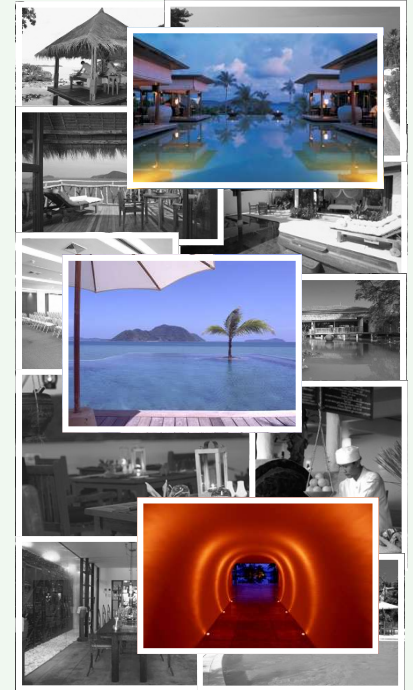
